



Pembroke Pines Campus **High School Off-Campus** **Authorization Agreement**

As parent or legal guardian of (print student's name) _____,

I hereby **GIVE PERMISSION** for this student to leave campus for lunch during the academic year at the Pines Campus ('14900 N.W. 20th Street, Pembroke Pines, FL 33028') as approved by Paladin Academy Administration. Permission will begin no earlier than the **5th of September 2017** and extends **to the end of the 2017-2018 school year**. I understand my student assumes responsibility for their actions during this time and I, as parent or guardian, are liable for those actions away from campus. I further understand that while **school policy prohibits a student from driving or being in a non-school vehicle during this time off-campus**, the school may not monitor my child during the period.

I understand that my student may not leave campus prior to lunch and must return to campus by the end of the lunch period *or as designated by administration*. No student is to purchase lunch for another non-high school child while off-campus. All students **are required to wear their buttoned, tucked in, uniform shirt or jacket while off campus**. **Students must sign in/out as appropriate**. Detention, loss of privileges, suspension and expulsion will be appropriate responses for such violations.

I understand that access to off-campus lunch is a privilege. With such privilege comes responsibility. I agree that my student is to act in a respectful and courteous manner at all times; the school expects student behavior to reflect positively on Paladin Academy. **Students are still bound by school policies while off campus including those dealing with controlled substances, uniform requirements, etc.** Detention, loss of privileges, suspension, expulsion and notification of law enforcement will be appropriate responses for such violations.

I understand that the school may require a class or personal meeting which would require my student to remain on campus during lunch. If asked or required, my student will meet the commitment regardless of when it is announced. I understand that a failure to meet a commitment whether intentionally or inadvertently may mean detention and loss of privileges. In addition, Paladin Academy may, at its sole discretion, suspend the off-campus privilege for scheduling, behavior, academic or safety reasons. I agree that notification to law enforcement may occur for a truant individual in the event my student should leave campus without authorization, with revoked approval, fail to return or **promptly contact**.

I release the school from all liability during this period. I assume full financial responsibility for any emergency services or reparations which may be required from my student's actions during this time. I also for myself, and on behalf of my student, do hereby Release, Indemnify and Hold Harmless, Nobel Learning Communities Inc., d/b/a Paladin Academy, and its employees with respect to any injury, disability, loss or damage to person or property (except for gross negligence or intentional misconduct exhibited by Paladin Academy) arising from or incident to my student's participation in this program.

It is understood that off-campus lunch opportunities exist **within two areas**. This includes the Coquinas Plaza located on Sheridan Street and Dykes Road, opposite side of Interstate 75. **A second area is available including only the Wendy's Restaurant located within the Pembroke Falls Business Center**. The school provided bus for drop-off and pick-up is the only approved transportation method to return to campus. Students are prohibited from walking back to campus. School administration reserves the right to conduct unannounced inspections during the lunch periods to monitor student behavior. Specifically, students are required to comply with the following requirements: (continued on reverse)

All Areas

I, and my student, understand opportunities may be available at the sole discretion of Paladin Academy administration for taking a school provided bus for drop-off/pick-up during scheduled lunch periods. This availability may change, with daily notice or due to extenuating circumstances. Students will board the bus immediately when their lunch period begins. Students **are prohibited from going to vehicles before departure/after return or bringing book bags** with them. Students are bound by bus behavior guidelines outlined in the parent-student handbook. I understand that my student is responsible for being at the assigned bus pickup location at the designated time **without exception**. It is understood that any student who is not present may be left behind to avoid a late return. In this case, such individuals should call the office and wait at the designated location for bus pickup. ***This is not optional***. Any student who is tardy for bus pickup will have their off-campus lunch privilege revoked for a period to be determined. Students are prohibited from walking back to campus.

Pembroke Falls Business Center

I, and my student, understand that opportunities for taking a school provided bus to the Wendy's Restaurant in the Pembroke Falls Business Center. I understand that my student **is strictly prohibited from visiting or walking on the property associated with Audi Pembroke Pines, Chevron, Cracker Barrel, Dunkin Donuts, Hampton Inn, Hampton Inn Business Complex, Holiday Inn Express, Lauderdale BMW of Pembroke Pines, Power Financial Credit Union, Public Storage and Stemtech International**. At no time should a student attempt to leave the property of the Wendy's Restaurant or attempt to walk back to the Pines Campus.

Coquinas Plaza (including Cinemark Plaza)

I, and my student, understand that opportunities for taking a school provided bus for drop-off to the Coquinas Plaza I understand that my student **is strictly prohibited from visiting or walking on the property associated with Ashley Furniture HomeStore, Cinemark Paradise 24 Theater (for any reason), Gamestop, CubeSmart Self Storage, Firestone Auto Care Store, Lowes Home Improvement Store (for any reason), Mr. Tux Sales & Rental, any bank, Everglades Animal Hospital** and other such establishments. While students are not strictly prohibited from visiting sit-down establishments: all individuals are reminded that no exceptions will be made for 'late food' or 'long lines' and that students are expected to be at the bus pick-up location on time.

Students are **required** to be with at least one other student while off campus. I agree that any student utilizing off-campus lunch must provide a contact cell phone number that can be reached during the period of time, whether theirs or those of a permanent group member. I understand students are **strictly prohibited from leaving the designated areas as stated above**. With items having been discussed, by signing the below I, and/or on behalf of my student, do agree to all terms and conditions.*
